

Postgraduate Diploma in Art Curatorship (PGDipArtCuratorship – 120 points)

These regulations must be read in conjunction with the General Regulations for the University.

1. Version

- (a) These Regulations came into force on 1 January 2018.
- (b) This Diploma was first offered in 2006.

2. Variations

In exceptional circumstances the Amo Matua, Toi Tangata | Executive Dean of Arts or delegate may approve a personal programme of study which does not conform to these Regulations.

3. The structure of the qualification

To qualify for the Diploma a student must satisfactorily pass all courses specified in the Schedule C for this Diploma. It is not possible to substitute another course.

4. Admission to the qualification

A student for the Postgraduate Diploma in Art Curatorship, before enrolling in the Diploma, must have

- (a) either:
 - i. qualified for the Degree of Bachelor of Arts or Bachelor of Fine Arts; or
 - ii. been admitted with Academic Equivalent Standing; or
 - iii. produced evidence to the satisfaction of Tumuaki Tari | Head of Department and the Amo Matua,
