

## ( 1 0 )

These regulations must be read in conjunction with the General Regulations for the University.

**1.**

- (a) These Regulations came into force on 1 July 2024.
- (b) This degree was first offered in 1993.

**2.**

In exceptional circumstances the Amo Matua, Pihanga | Executive Dean of Engineering or delegate may approve a personal programme of study which does not conform to these Regulations.

**3.**

To qualify for the Master of Engineering Management degree a student be credited with:

- (a) a minimum of 180 points towards the qualification; and
- (b) 30 points from either Schedule C Group 1 or Schedule C Group 2 and all courses from Schedule C Group 3 to these Regulations; and
- (c) At least 15 points from the electives listed in Schedule E to these Regulations. A student may select (c)

This qualification adheres to the General Regulations for the University and may be awarded with distinction and merit.

10.

- (a) There is no advancing qualification for this degree.
- (b) A student who has not met the requirements for the Master of Engineering Management but who has met the requirements of the Postgraduate Diploma in Engineering Management may apply to withdraw from the degree and be awarded the Postgraduate Diploma in Engineering Management.
