



**If you've just completed your high school studies but can't get to New Zealand in time to start at UC in July, you can start at UC International College in October and transfer to UC in February.**

### **Who is eligible**

Students who have completed high school studies in their home country and are planning to start at UC in February 2025.

Bachelor of Commerce (BCom) and Bachelor of Science (BSc)

Applicants must be accepted to UC International College (UCIC) and have completed the UCIC program. UCIC students can transfer to UC in February 2025.





## Application process

1. Complete the UCIC application form  
2. Submit your application to UCIC  
3. UCIC will review your application  
4. UCIC will contact you if you are successful  
5. UCIC will provide you with the necessary information to apply for a visa  
6. UCIC will provide you with the necessary information to apply for a student loan  
7. UCIC will provide you with the necessary information to apply for a scholarship  
8. UCIC will provide you with the necessary information to apply for a bursary  
9. UCIC will provide you with the necessary information to apply for a grant  
10. UCIC will provide you with the necessary information to apply for a stipend
